#### **Seed Potatoes**

Now is the time to start thinking about planting seed potatoes. These can be bought in store by the bag or loose.

Place your potatoes by a warm window to help them start to shoot. When they have started to shoot reduce

the number of shoots down to 4. Picking the strongest. Plant them in well cultivated soil approx 30cm apart. In time your potatoes will produce vigorous growth. Harvest when the leaves start to die



back. Just dig enough for each meal and enjoy.

No room to plant potatoes! No problem.

Grab an old bucket and drill a hole in the bottom. Fill with a general purpose compost and plant two potatoes in the bucket. Keep well watered. Again harvest when the leaves start to die back. This is a great idea for growing potatoes with children as they can really get involved and enjoy the results.
