Love your hedgehog



Hedgehogs are the gardeners friend. Look after your hedgehog because it will help look after your garden by eating slugs, snails and other pests that can damage plants.

Help them by placing food out for them at night. Not during the day as it might attract flies which will lay eggs in it. Do not give them bread and milk as it will give your hedgehog diarrhoea which could result in dehydration and even death. They will eat cat food but do not really like fish flavours. Spike's is a specially forumated hedgehog food which we keep in stock. This is a good way of ensuring a healthy and safe diet.

Try not to use traditional slug pellets as these can harm hedgehogs. We stock a number of safe product for the treatment of slugs and snails.

So go on look after your hedgehog.

Andrew's Top Tip — Carpet Cleaning

Spring is one of the most popular times of the year for customers hiring our Rug Doctor carpet cleaning machines. This got me thinking about carpet cleaning in more detail.



We are frequently asked for help and advice on carpet cleaning and stain removal. There are many products on the market which can help but we like to keep it simple and we recommend only a few products which we know

For simple marks and spillages we always recommend Hagesan Spot and Stain Remover. This has to be one of the most remarkable products we stock. To give you an idea of how good it is - I once dropped a tin of prunes on a sand coloured carpet at home. I sponged up most of the dark brown liquid with a cloth and then used HG Spot and Stain Remover and every drop of discoloration came out of the carpet. Its also ideal for

removing grubbed in stains. Just spray, leave for a while and blot up. The product now comes in two strengths. (We always keep a bottle handy for those unexpected little household accidents as results are even better if the stain is tackled quickly).

If you decide to give your carpets the five star cleaning treatment then the Rug Doctor is clearly the answer. I can assure you that even in the cleanest of households you will be astonished at how much dirt will come out of a carpet. The shampoo contains Scotchguard so you will be protecting your carpets against future stains. For heavy traffic areas there is a pre-treatment which helps dislodge surface dirt. (Tip a stiff clean deck-broom can help the pre-treatment be absorbed by the carpet. It will also help lift tired pile before cleaning). The Rug Doctor can be hired for £22.99 for a 24hr period. Identification will be required and a £10 refundable deposit is charged.

Plant of the Month

Ceanothus - a favorite of my late grandmother who had a wonderful specimen at the bottom of her garden.



Ceanothus comes from the family Rhannaceae which is found mainly in North America. Most plants are evergreen but deciduous varieties are found in colder countries. The plant has tiny blue flowers which are formed into clusters as shown in the picture. The most common colour of flower is blue with various shades being available.

Your plant will grow to

between 1.5m and 2.5m in both height and width so allow plenty of room for this shrub. It is suited to a sunny well drained position. Ideally the plant prefers a sheltered position away from strong

An interesting fact is that the Native Americans used the leaves as a herbal tea. (Prefer Twinings Green Blend myself).

Ceanothus is also known as the California Lilac.

There's still time to plant seed potatoes, onions, garlic and shallots. All the popular varieties are in stock!
