Andrew's Top Tip — That Sticky Feeling

We are always being asked to advise on the most appropriate glue for a particular job. The answer is now really very simple — Gorilla Glue.



Gorilla products have been on the market for a few years now and those customers who have used them know how strong they are. The product range includes the usual wood and super glues in a number of useful sizes. They are clearly some of the best products of their class in the market. The price is good too! And the best bit — you won't be wasting your money.

Plant of the Month

Begonia Bonfire

This genus of flowering plants belongs to the Begoniaceae family of plants with some 1400 different species.

They typically originate from tropical and sub-tropical regions including South and Central America, Africa and Asia. In colder climates such as the UK they are usually grown as summer plants or as house plants.

In recent years a new variety called Begonia Bonfire has emerged. This is an incredible plant and one which I have stocked in the garden centre and grown personally at home.

This year it's popularity has grown, featuring in publications such as Gardener's World.

Why do I like it? It's what I call a good value plant! Whilst the £3.99 price tag may seem expensive when compared to other begonias it does provide value for money. One plant will fill a 10" pot or hanging basket. Three plants in a 14" or 16" basket will give a

stunning display. The flowers last all season and dead heading is so simple. Just give the plant pot a gentle shake and all of the old flowers simply drop off to encourage the growth of new blooms. It is also relatively tolerant of dryer conditions. This means less frequent watering of baskets and pots.

Demand for this plant has been high in previous years so if you would like to grow this please do call in store before our supplies run out.

Don't forget to feed your baskets with either a slow release or soluble fertilizer during the summer months.

Delivery Service



As a service to our customers we are more than happy to deliver locally within, Brundall, Blofield, Blofield Heath, Strumpshaw and Lingwood. We do not charge for this service and will usually have your goods delivered to you within two working days. Very often on the same day. Should you be out when we deliver we will leave you goods in a place agreed with you in advance. We would ask for a minimum spend of £15 outside Brundall for a delivery. We will not deliver in icy or dangerous conditions.
