Andrew's Top Tip — Water Stains

OK we've all had a slight problem at home with a water stain on a ceiling or wall. Usually caused by a leaking pipe or some damp coming in from outside. Very often this is just a mark on the ceiling which does not seem to disappear with a coat of emulsion. In worst case scenarios you may experience a build up of black mould which stains the decoration.

Customers regularly ask us about such problems and the good news there is a way to stop the stain from reoccurring. The first thing to do is ensure that the source of the staining has been repaired. This can be difficult if it is a leaky roof or gutter but no amount of redecoration will help if the cause of the problem is not resolved.

In cases of black mould wash the area with Blackfriars Mould Solution. This will kill off the mould spores and help clean the affected area. Black marks will most likely remain. The next step applies to all water or mould marks. Cover them in a Stain Block product. We stock products from different manufacturers. These covers the marks and prevents them from showing through again in the future. You can then redecorate with emulsion.



One word of caution. Don't use an oil based paint as a Stain Block alternative. You may struggle to get emulsion to paint over the top.

Plant of the Month

Echinacea

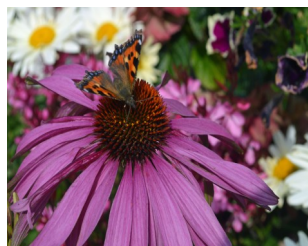
The herbaceous flowering plant is part of the daisy family. It is commonly called Coneflower. Echinacea originates in parts of eastern, central or northern parts of Africa. It can be found in prairie and open woodland areas.

The name comes from the Greek word, Echino meaning sea urchin. This originates from the shape of the flower. This plant is reported to have many health benefits and is often used in alternative medicine.

This perennial plant can

grow up to 4' and is generally grown for its strong showy flowers.

It will look good towards the back of the perennial border and would mix well with other daisy flowers.

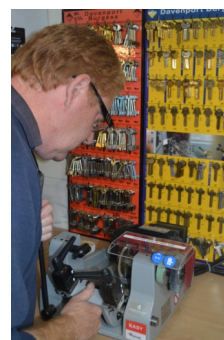
