Last month we introduced a 5p minimum charge for all carrier bags requested at the till. During the first month 117 bags were requested. This is a significant reduction on the number of bags that we would normally expect to issue. We have no immediate plans to charge for plastic plant carriers or bags used for our loose bird and pet foods. We continue to look for more environmentally friendly solutions to carrier bags.
