In the garden sector a number of chemical companies are starting to acknowledge that some chemicals may be having a detrimental affect on our bee population. Whilst the debate on the impact of neonicotinoids in many pest control products is still very much under discussion,

(there is some evidence that neonicotinoids may be linked to declining bee populations) some manufacturers are starting to introduce less harmful solutions.

At Brundall Home Hardware we continue to offer a selection of pest control products but would encourage our customers to consider some of the more environmentally friendly solutions.

We also like to try and encourage bee activity in the garden centre. To this end you will find many bee friendly plants such as Lavender. On a sunny afternoon you can hear the Garden Centre humming with the sound of bees. Many of our plant suppliers will now indicate on their plant labels if a specific plant is bee or butterfly friendly.

If you really enjoy bees we can also offer you the chance to purchase the fruits of their labour. In the shop you will find jars of locally produced honey. These are priced at £5.99 in either set or runny varieties.

best way to apply Patio Magic is via a hand pressure sprayer. Simply dilute with water and spray onto hard surfaces.







