Annual Stock Take — Revised Opening Hours

Just to add to the fun and excitement of living through a pandemic we now have the joy of our annual stock take.

We usually do this whilst the shop is open and close off the odd area of the shop to permit staff to count stock. This year we will need to do something a bit different as it will not be possible to operate safely whilst the shop is open.

Therefore, we will be closing the shop at 3pm between Monday 18 January and Friday 29th January, (excluding Saturday 23rd January where we will remain open until 5pm).

This will leave our team a few hours at the end of each day to complete the stock take.

We have recently looked at the database which supports our till system and have deleted many unnecessary records. This will help speed up the processing of transactions but also helps to ensure that our stock take is more accurate.

The good news is that we no longer have to undertake a stock take using the pen and paper method. Our till system has the necessary technology to help us and we just simply need to scan in all of the 7000 plus different product lines we have in store.
